Double-check included

- ☐ Protection and dust control

Clarify before signing

- ☐ How many trips are expected?
- ☐ Is painting included?
- ☐ Is texture matching included?
- ☐ Is the cause of damage fixed?
- ☐ How will dust be controlled?
- ☐ Will the patch be blended or the whole wall/ceiling painted?

Common budget surprises

- ☐ Multiple return trips
- ☐ Water damage source not fixed
- ☐ Texture mismatch
- ☐ Paint color mismatch
- ☐ Ceiling work being harder than wall work
- ☐ Furniture/content protection

Ways to save without cutting corners

- ☐ Group small repairs into one visit.
- ☐ Fix the leak/source before patching.
- ☐ Paint a full wall/ceiling section when blending is unrealistic.
- ☐ Move small contents before the visit.
- ☐ Be realistic about texture and paint matching.

Helpful prep before the visit

- ☐ Take a photo with a tape measure for scale.
- ☐ Confirm the leak/source is fixed.
- ☐ Move furniture and fragile items if possible.
- ☐ Identify whether texture is present.
- ☐ Find leftover paint if available.
